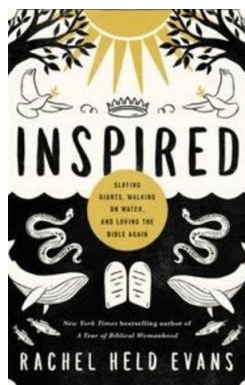


Ficklin Food Fund
